

Thanksgiving mini pack: a picture hunt and bingo

One picture hunt for little ones who can't read yet, and two bingo cards for the kids' table. Print it before the guests arrive; it keeps kids busy while the turkey roasts.

How to play

- 1 Print pages 2 and 3 at 100% (Actual size). Clip each page to a clipboard or a piece of cardboard.
- 2 Page 2: find each thing in the house and color in its circle. Decorations and pictures count!
- 3 Page 3: two bingo cards. Spot it around the house or out the window, color the square; four in a row wins.
- 4 No answer key: every find counts, and helping each other counts double.

Safety first

- The kitchen is look-only: keep kids at least 3 feet from the stove and oven.
- Ask the cook about allergens before kids taste anything new.
- Keep turkey bones, fatty scraps and chocolate away from the family dog.
